Are you under 65 and from a culturally or linguistically diverse background?

If so, we may be able to assist you, and the person who cares for you, to access culturally appropriate support services.

Our experienced staff are specifically trained to work with people from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds.

How can we assist you?

Our Cultural and Linguistic Diversity (CALD) program will:

- help you and your family understand what support services are available to you. This may include support from Queensland Community Care, the NDIS, Carers Queensland and other relevant services
- help determine if you are eligible for services
- assist you to contact and communicate with these services
- talk to individuals and other service providers to make sure you are getting the services you need.

Am I eligible?

You are eligible for our Cultural and Linguistic Diversity (CALD) program if you:

- are from a CALD background and under 65 years old
- are a person with a medical problem, disability, mental illness, or a family member providing care for someone with these conditions
- require basic support services to remain in your home, and support for the person who cares for you.



Service providers and community groups

We provide CALD information, education, and training to service providers and community groups. This may include:

- developing and providing training to service providers and community groups to help them understand CALD perspectives and issues
- promoting Carers Queensland and the CALD program at multicultural community events
- promoting collaboration, information sharing and best practice.

Carers Queensland can work with you to develop cultural information, awareness, and training resources that are tailored to meet the needs of your workplace or community.
